Trail Guidelines & Restrictions

- All trail guests—stay right; the traffic is two-way. Please throw away all trash in receptacle
- Bikers—slow down and announce your intent to pass
- Pet owners—leashed animals are permitted; remove/clean up all animal waste
- Anglers—no fishing from bridge.
 Leave no trash behind
- Motorized vehicles are restricted on all trails
- Trails are handicap accessible but consist of crushed rock and mowed grass
- No camping or fires are allowed
- Hours: the property is open from sunrise to sunset. Main gate is locked daily, shortly after sunset.
